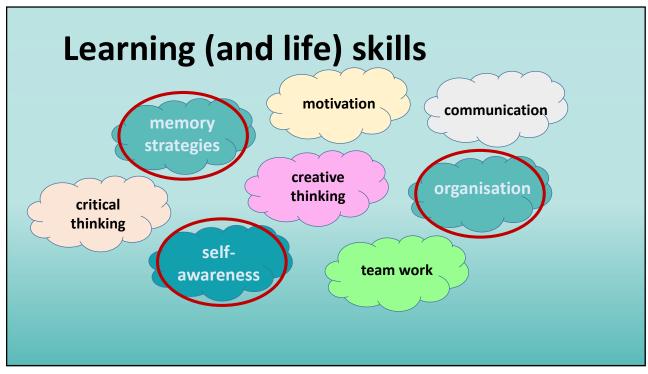

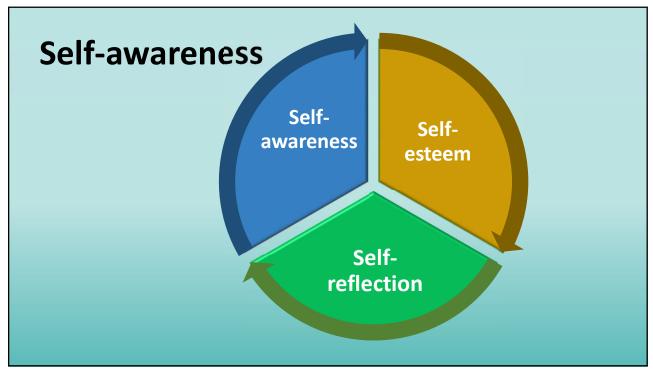

#### Self-esteem

#### Low self esteem

can be more debilitating than being neurodiverse.



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#### Low self-esteem - causes

- unrealistic expectations (from parents / self / school)
- > previous negative experiences
- comments from teachers / peers (may have been misinterpreted)
- > superficial comparison of self to others

# How can we boost self-esteem?

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# Boost self-awareness through reflection on learning I need to practise: recognise and say /p/ write P/p in words

say these words:

## Video project: "Hire me!"

#### Aims:

- ✓ to highlight students' special qualities or talents
- ✓ to develop persuasive techniques

Ask each student to plan and shoot a 2-3 min video. They may need / want to work in pairs.

Pre-teach vocabulary related to character / personality.

Help students plan & structure their work.

Write the names of all the students in the class on separate pieces of paper.

Give one to each student (not themselves!)

Tell them to thank that person for something they have done to make the class / course special.

E.g. Thank you, X, for always having spare paper / laughing at my jokes / opening the blinds.....

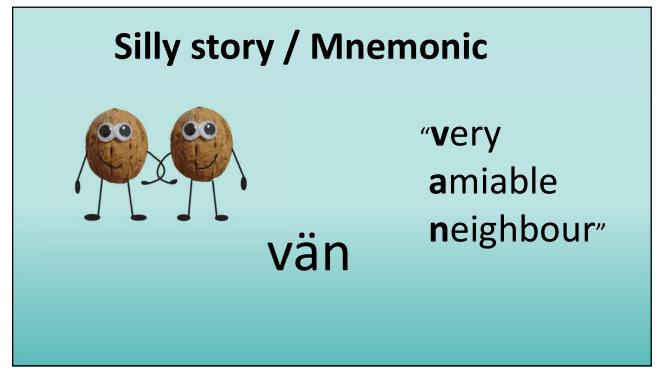




# Memory picture 'friend' in Swedish
